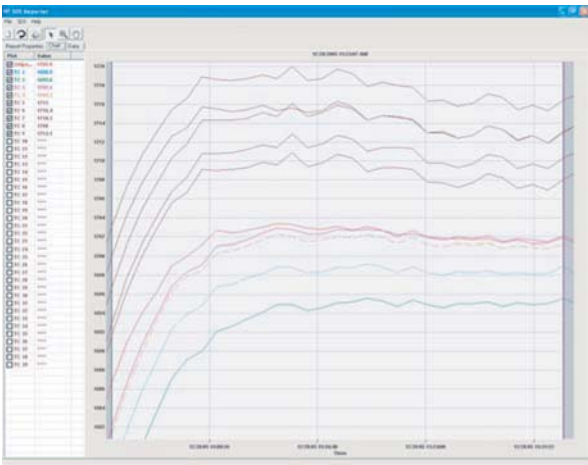
## Multi-Channel Data Logger

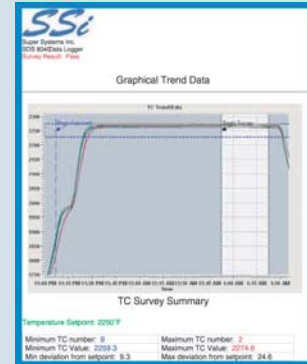
